Dr. Lauren Geaney is a fellowship trained foot and ankle surgeon and assistant professor of orthopedic surgery at the UConn Musculoskeletal Institute at UConn Health. She completed both her medical training and orthopedic training at UConn. Dr. Geaney then completed her foot and ankle fellowship at Mercy Medical Center in Baltimore, Maryland under the leadership of Dr. Mark Myerson.



Elizabeth Martin, MD

Dr. Elizabeth Martin is a board certified, fellowship trained Orthopaedic Surgeon in the Brigham Division of Foot and Ankle and a member of the faculty at Harvard Medical School. She specializes in complex reconstructive surgery of the foot and ankle. Her clinical interests include foot and ankle trauma, post-traumatic pain, sports injuries, foot and ankle arthritis and deformities such as painful flatfoot and bunions. Her research interests include foot and ankle trauma, improving quality of life for foot and ankle patients and orthopaedic education.



Bopha Chrea, MD

Dr. Chrea is a fellowship trained and board-certified orthopaedic surgeon on faculty at UI hospital & Clinics with sub-specialized expertise in foot and ankle disorders. Following her residency at the University of Mississippi, she underwent fellowship training in foot and ankle surgery at Hospital for Special Surgery in New York City. Her research interests include ankle arthritis and Charcot-Marie-Tooth Disease.

Dr. Elizabeth Cody completed her orthopedic surgery residency at HSS after receiving her undergraduate degree from Princeton and her medical degree from Columbia University's College of Physicians and Surgeons. She completed a fellowship in foot and ankle surgery at Duke University, where she worked with world-renowned surgeons and assisted on many complex surgeries throughout the foot and ankle, including more than 70 total ankle replacements. She has experience treating foot and ankle arthritis, foot and ankle injuries, ankle instability, and congenital and acquired foot deformities, including flatfoot and hallux valgus (bunion) deformities. As a Division I collegiate rower and lifelong athlete, she has a particular interest in treating athletes.
